YTL Group offices around the Region

- Will switch off non-essential lighting and unplug non-essential equipment before leaving the building on Friday, 29th March 2019, the day before Earth Hour
- Raise awareness
- Employee Communication: Email blasts on Earth Hour, Earth Hour video, Tips on saving energy at the office and home, Updates on YTL Earth Hour website and hashtags

YTL Singapore Office

- Continue to turn the lights off in the office every Friday during lunch time
- Continue to recycle all waste plastic, metal and paper in the bins provided

Wisma Atria, Singapore

- The mall and its tenants will be switching off non-essential lights on 30th March 2019 from 8.30pm-9.30pm
- WWF Roadshow at indoor event space level 1 from 25th -31st March 2019 (showcase of climate change and interactive activities)

- ***The Ritz-Carlton, Koh Samui***
 - Promote guest participation by encouraging them to decorate or make a note on a notice board in regards of Earth Hour
 - Turn off non-essential lights at Baan Talat and public area
 - During lights-off event, candles will be used to illuminate dining tables as well as the walkway to Baan Talat
 - A series of candles arranging into Earth Hour “60+” logo will be ignited by guests
 - A Northern Candle Dance will be performed by dancers
- ***The Surin Phuket***
 - Light-off in the main building including the lobby, library, Sunset restaurant (A candle will be provided on each table) & Beach Bar during Earth hour

- ***Spa Village Tembok, Bali***
 - Dinner on the beach with camp-fire and Balinese Gamelan Orchestra
 - Non-essential lights will be turned off

 - The Lobby (RCKL & JWMKL):

 - Lights will be turned off from 8.30pm to 9.30pm

 - Guests will be invited to join a candlelit cocktails session from 8.30pm to 9.30pm. The cocktails will be priced reasonably low to encourage guests to join. Candles will be set inside The Library and the lights will be dimmed

 - The Lobby (JWMKL):
 - Low carbon cocktails will be served around for guest to enjoy from 8.30pm to 9.30pm

 - Employee Engagement Activity (RCKL & JWMKL):
 - A yoga session will be arranged at JWMKL Pool area for the associates (around 40pax) with candle light from 8.30pm to 9.30pm

- ***Vistana Kuantan City Centre***
 - Refreshments will be served together with some interesting game activities

- ***Tanjong Jara Resort***
 - Welcome speech and explanation of Earth hour
 - Low energy consumption dinner
 - Night walk with lanterns through the resort
 - Candles will be lit up around the resort

FrogAsia
